THP Commitment

- We commit to GATHER weekly at our gatherings, and love and encourage both those in our ministry, and those who attend. We see this as our corporate act of worship. (Heb 10:23-25)
 - Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near. -Hebrews 10:23-25
- We commit to GROW in faith with others on the journey. We understand this happens best in the context of relationships. We commit to be in a small group. (Acts 2:42-47)
 - All the believers devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching, and to fellowship, and to sharing in meals (including the Lord's Supper), and to prayer. A deep sense of awe came over them all, and the apostles performed many miraculous signs and wonders. And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need. They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity all the while praising God and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved. -Acts 2:42-47
- We commit to GIVE of our time, talents, and treasure. We understand
 this means giving of our time and finances. We commit to be
 generous in our giving as we believe the words of Jesus, "it is more
 blessed to give than to receive." (Acts 20:35, Mal. 3:10)

- And I have been a constant example of how you can help those in need by working hard. You should remember the words of the Lord Jesus: 'It is more blessed to give than to receive."
